Scoring System:

# a) The Best Article Award

The articles will be judged anonymously by three judges.

- 50 marks will be given by each judge to each submitted article
   (20 marks for academic; 20 marks for interest; 10 marks for clarity).
- Marks given by the three judges will be added up to be the final marks for each participant.
- > The winner of this award should be the one with the highest marks.

## b) The Most Popular Award

- The articles will be voted anonymously by the public on Facebook.
- > The winner of this award should be the one with the highest number of votes.
- In case of two or more candidates receiving the same number of votes, the one with higher marks given by the judges will be the winner of this award.

## **General Contest Rules and Regulations**

- 1. The main theme of the Article Contest is "Creative Chemistry in Washroom". Members may include the following in their articles:
  - a. Chemistry behind washroom products (e.g. chemical nature, manufacturing process, working principle...)
  - b. Creative applications of washroom products
- 2. The article should be no more than ONE side of an A4 page (with pictures for better illustration of ideas is preferred).
- 3. The format should be Times New Roman with font size of 12. The spacing should be 1.0. Words should be written inside the margin (top, bottom, left and right with 1"

- spacing).
- 4. Any sources must be cited with appropriate style and a reference list should be included (No length limit to the reference list).
- 5. The submitted file (article + reference list) should be in PDF file.
- 6. Names (both Chinese and English), UID and contact numbers of the participants should be stated clearly in the email.
- 7. Participants can submit their articles at any time before the deadline by sending the file to our Society email: <a href="mailto:chemsoc@hku.hk">chemsoc@hku.hk</a> (with subject and file name of Article Contest UID).
- 8. Late submission will not be accepted.
- 9. Plagiarism is not allowed. All submitted articles will be forwarded to the Turnitin system. Participants will be disqualified if their articles contain serious plagiarism (decided by judges).
