Itinerary: Victoria Peak (By Peak Tram) – Stanley Market – Repulse Bay

Victoria Peak (By Peak Tram) / 10:00-12:00

In the morning, you will travel to the Peak where you can enjoy the views of the Victoria Harbour and the Kowloon Peninsula. The harbour view with a backdrop of sky-scrappers is breathtaking and should not be missed.



Stanley Market / 12:00-16:30

After visiting the Peak, you will go to Stanley Market where participants are free to explore the place and try the international cuisine at their own cost. Stanley Market is a shoppers' paradise where you can find a wide variety of souvenirs such as silk, garments, sportswear, Chinese artwork and accessories.



Repulse Bay /16:30-17:30

The Repulse Bay beach which is a popular with locals and visitors. The ornate Life Guard Club is built in traditional Chinese style. Its ceiling is decorated with magnificent swirling dragons. The picturesque gardens that lead down to the beach are guarded by the statues of Kwun Yum and Tin Hau, the protectors of fishermen.
