Use Fentanyl with Great Care

Fentanyl is a potent opioid analgesics indicated for patients with chronic severe pain. Inappropriate use may cause serious or life-threatening side effects. Thus, patient should follow the directions for use to prevent death or side effects from overdose.

Here are some recommendations for patients using fentanyl patch.

- Do not use fentanyl patch on an open wound as this can cause you to receive too much medication. Before applying the patch, ensure the patch is intact as using a damaged patch can expose you to a potentially fatal dose
- 2. Heat may increase the amount of fentanyl passing into your body and creates a risk of overdose. Therefore, fentanyl patch should not be used with heat pads, electric blankets and heat lamps. If you get a fever higher than 102°F, call your physician right away.
- 3. Fentanyl patch should be kept out the reach of children
- 4. Used patches should be thrown away by folding the sticky sides of the patch together
