Course Title/Code:

Research Seminars in Obstetrics and Gynaecology (MMPH6147)

Department:

Obstetrics & Gynaecology

Objective:

The research seminars on Obstetrics and Gynaecology provide students with a broader understanding of research in obstetrics, reproductive medicine, gynaecology and oncology.

Content:

The research topics are the most up-to-date research areas in obstetrics and gynaecology. Many of the cutting-edge techniques (e.g. primary cell/cancer cell manipulation, gene-transfer and manipulation, ES cell cultures, genomic and epigenetics techniques) will be used to study basic scientific/medical question in different research areas. Special features of this course include 2 lectures on (1) how to clearly present your research work; (2) how to read and write biomedical Research and review papers; and 2 hour oral presentations of his/her own research work.

Learning outcomes:

On completion of the course, the students are expected to

- formulate hypothesis and use different cutting-edge technique to address the basic scientific/biomedical questions
- understand the relevant research topics in obstetrics, reproductive medicine, gynaecology and oncology
- present their research findings clearly and systematically

Prerequisite:

BSc or medical graduate

Duration:

Two semester, 2 hours/month, 20 contact hours, 4 hours lectures and presentations

Assessment:

60% continuous assessment (attendance and discussion)

20% presentation

20% abstract and review writing
