Focusing on the theme of Recovery and Renewal, the 2018 Young Leaders Tour of Japan will provide TEN eligible undergraduate students from HKU with an exciting opportunity to visit sites in Miyagi Prefecture and Tokyo to learn how Mitsubishi Corporation is helping businesses recover seven years after the 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake. As future leaders, students will be encouraged to think about global problems such as recovering from natural disasters, reconstruction, and corporate social responsibility initiatives in society.

We will visit a variety of local businesses and organisations in Miyagi, and conclude the tour in Tokyo with sightseeing activities, a visit to the Mitsubishi Corporation Head Office in Marunouchi, and dinner with HKU alumni.

Airfare, accommodation, meals and local transport will be provided. Students will be responsible for any incidental or personal expenses.

Eligibility Criteria

Undergraduate students currently in year 2, 3, and 4 who have declared a major or minor in Japanese Studies. Students must demonstrate a medium-level Japanese language proficiency.
