To ensure a smooth and enjoyable ceremony, briefing and rehearsal before the Ceremony are important and necessary. You are requested to <u>arrive at the Grand Hall at 08:00</u>.

#### 3 Rundown

08:00

- a) Present your namecard at the entrance of the Grand Hall upon your arrival;
- b) Put on your academic dress. You may refer to the website at http://www3.hku.hk/congreg/index.php/academic\_dress for the proper way to wear academic dress; and
- c) Be seated according to the seat number printed on your namecard.

08:15 - 09:30

Briefing and Rehearsal

[\*\* Please refer to the following Proceedings for the arrangement in the Ceremony.]

Guests will be allowed to enter the Hall from 09:30 and must be seated before 09:45. No quest will be allowed to enter the Hall between 09:45 and 10:20.]

\*\*\* Please return to your assigned seat after rehearsal and do not leave after 09:45.

#### 10:00 - 11:30 Graduation Ceremony Proceedings:

- a) Procession music will begin shortly after 10:00. The Congregation will stand during the entry of the Procession.
- b) The Procession will enter the Hall, ascend the stage and stand. National Anthem will be played.

The Procession members and the Congregation will be seated after music ends.

- c) The Master of Ceremonies will declare the opening of the Graduation Ceremony.
- d) All PhD, PsyD and MPhil graduands should stand up QUIETLY and line up according to the sequence of your number printed on the namecard, in ascending order, along the designated aisle (please refer to the enclosed seating plan).
- e) The Associate Dean (Postgraduate Education) will be invited to present individual graduand to the Vice-Chancellor.
- f) Each *PhD*, *PsyD* and *MPhil* graduand, wearing hood, and holding cap in left hand, will mount to the stage by the <u>left steps</u>. Halt in front of the Associate Dean, and hand the namecard to her. When the Associate Dean calls your name, please proceed and stop in front of the Vice-Chancellor. Shake hands with him and bow to the audience. Descend the stage by the right steps, and return to your seat and be seated.
- g) When the Associate Dean is presenting the PhD, PsyD and MPhil graduands, all Taught Postgraduate graduands including PCPsych, PDipIA and Bachelor graduands should follow the onsite instructions and proceed QUIETLY to the designated aisle and line up after the last graduand of the previous degree.

h) Each Taught Postgraduate and Bachelor graduand, wearing hood, and holding cap in left hand, will mount to the stage by the <a href="left steps">left hand</a>, wearing hood, and holding cap in left hand, will mount to the stage by the <a href="left steps">left steps</a>. Halt before the Associate Dean/Head/Director and hand the namecard to him/her. When he/she calls your name, please proceed and stop in front of the Vice-Chancellor, and bow to him. Then face to the audience and bow again. Descend the stage by the right steps and return to your seat and be seated.


#### Notes to Graduands on Photo Arrangements


#### Floor Plan

# Additional Notes to Graduands of Postgraduate Certificate in Psychology (PCPsych) and Postgraduate Diploma in International Affairs (PDipIA)

To: All PCPsych and PDipIA Graduands Attending the Graduation Ceremony

The Faculty has reserved some black gowns (without cap and hood) for PCPsych and PDipIA graduands. The black gown will be available for your collection at the Faculty Office, Room 401, Meng Wah Complex, from <u>December 1 to December 3, 2010</u> (Wednesday – Friday: 9:00am - 1:00pm & 2:00pm - 6:00pm). Prior to your collection of the gown, you are required to pay a cash deposit of HK\$300 at the Faculty Office.
