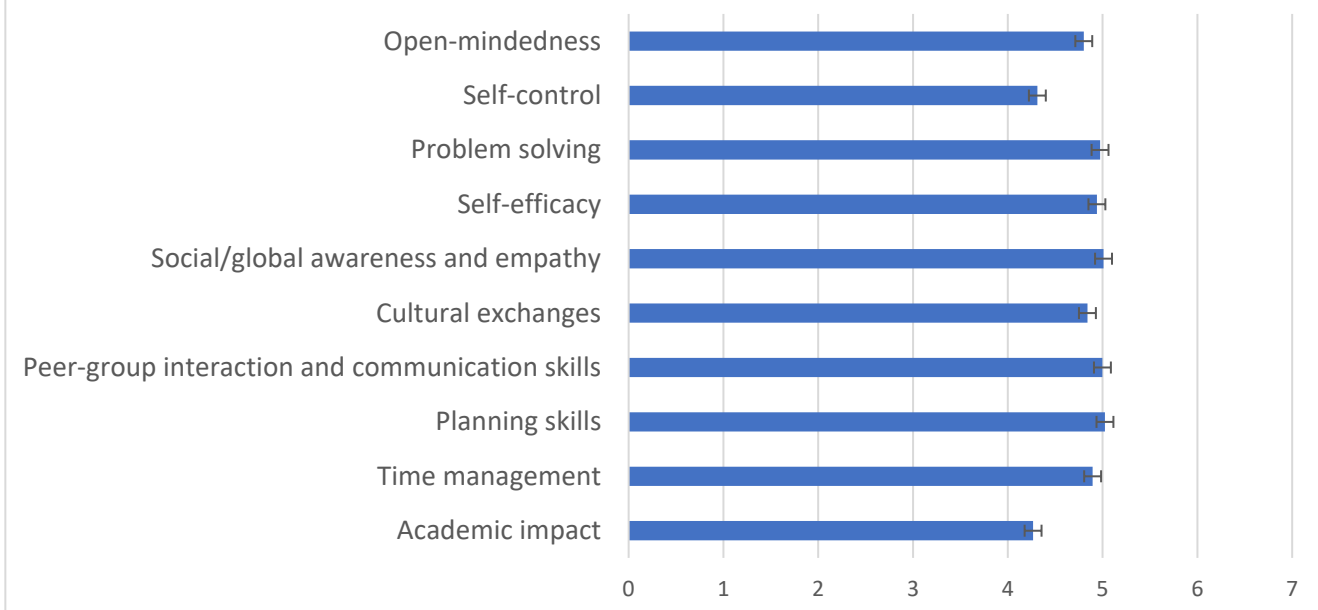


Figure 1. The Impact of Hall Experience on different developmental aspects of participants
