Master of Science in Environmental Management

- 1. Applications are invited for admission in September 2024 to read for the degree of Master of Science in Environmental Management. To be eligible for admission to the programme, a candidate shall satisfy both the University Admission Requirements and the Programme Specific Requirements as listed below:
 - (a) shall comply with the <u>General Regulations</u>;
 - (b) shall hold a Bachelor's degree of this University or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
 - (c) shall satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.
 - (d) for a candidate who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to high degrees as prescribed under <u>General</u> <u>Regulation G2(b)</u>.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case by case basis.

- 2. The MSc(EnvMan) is an inter-faculty multi-disciplinary coursework programme. The programme will involve part-time study for a period of two years or full-time study for one year.
- 3. The programme provides a comprehensive training in the field of environmental management, addressing both the major environmental problems and their social, legal and economic context.

- Starting from the Academic Year 2020-21, ENVM8020 Green Building and Energy Management has been accredited by <u>Hong Kong Green Building Council Limited</u> (<u>HKGBC</u>) and <u>BEAM Society Limited (BSL</u>). Students upon passing the examination of the course and completing the MSc(EnvMan) programme will be eligible to register as a <u>BEAM Affiliate</u> at HKGBC.

- 8. Applications will be considered immediately until all places are filled. The results of the admissions exercise are expected to be announced as soon as possible but no later than late August 2024. For non-local students, they are advised to apply as early as possible to ensure completing all entry visa requirements prior to the commencement of the programme (It may take up to 3 months to process the entry visa).
- 9. To facilitate the screening process, please input information of referee(s) through the Online Application. All applicants must provide at least one referee. The University will send email invitations to the referee(s) for completing the Online Reference Form via a designated online platform within four weeks from the date of successful submission of the application. The closing date for non-local application is 12:00 noon (GMT +8), April 30, 2024 and that for local application is 12:00 noon (GMT +8), June 28, 2024.
